Membership Rules

1. The Olden Community Garden is available for use by Members during daylight hours. Users of the Garden and its facilities do so at their own risk. We are a working Garden, on a steep terraced site adjoining a railway line, **so everyone must be careful.**
2. Anyone entering the Garden must observe the COVID restrictions that may be in place in Islington at the time of the visit. **To minimise risk, the Garden House is for use by our gardeners only,** for the foreseeable future.
3. **Garden Members are responsible for their guests and their actions.**
4. All children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
5. Members and their families are asked to respect the Garden, its plants, borders and trees and the facilities.
6. No ball games are allowed in the Garden, and no scooting or cycling.
7. No dogs are allowed in the Garden, except for Guide and Hearing dogs.
8. No smoking in the Garden House.
9. Use of music making devices (except with headphones) or live music is not permitted in the Garden, except by prior arrangement with the Management Committee
10. Anyone who deliberately litters or causes deliberate damage to any area of the Garden will face immediate expulsion from the membership. Members are responsible for their guests.
11. Keep the Garden tidy. Do not leave your rubbish behind – take it home.
12. As the Garden is in a residential area, Members are asked to be considerate and to keep any noise to a minimum.
13. Access to the Garden is operated by a touch pad entry system. **Members are asked not to share the confidential pin code with anyone,** except immediate family, as this could result in membership being withdrawn.
